Shelters do not have cots, blankets, or other supplies. You will need to bring identification and your own chairs, bedding (cot, air mattress, pillow, etc), toiletries, food, water, pet food and prescriptions to the shelter.

IF YOU STAY AT HOME HAVE THE FOLLOWING ON HAND:

House hold essentials

- _ Battery or hand cranked flashlights
- _ Utility knife
- _ whistle
- _ pencil, paper
- _ needle & thread
- _ bleach
- _ manual can opener
- _ thermal blankets
- _ tape, duct tape
- _ matches
- _ paper plates, cups, utensils
- _ cooking tools
- _ eye wear

First aid and medical

- _ hearing aid batteries
- _ glucose test strips & diabetic monitors
- _ glasses, contact lenses and supplies
- _ denture supplies
- _ first-aid kit with two pairs of sterile gloves, soap and antibiotic wipes, bandages, stretch gauze and roll tape, thermometer, antacid, petroleum jelly, sterile dressings, antibiotic cream, eye wash, aspirin or non-aspirin pain reliever, anti-diarrhea medication, scissors, tweezers, hydrogen peroxide

Personal essentials

- _ toiletries
- _ toothbrush, paste, comb, brush
- _ suitable, seasonal clothing, including socks, rain gear and proper shoes
- _ cell phone & chargers
- _ extra set of car/house keys
- _ sleeping bags
- _ books, puzzles, board/card games
- _ important document in waterproof container (i.e., medical records, bank account numbers, social security & insurance cards)

Food

- _ nonperishable food
- _ salt-free crackers, whole grain cereals,
- _ canned foods with high liquid content
- _ peanut butter
- _ canned juices
- _ comfort foods
- _ dried fruits, nuts, dry cereal, granola

Water

- _ enough water for 3-7 days
- _ one gallon of water per day per person
