

9<sup>th</sup> hole: The ideal tee shot for the closing hole on the front nine is down the right center, which will open the green up for the second shot. The fairway tilts left allowing tee shots down the right side to bounce back into play. The front left of the green is guarded by a large oak tree which will come into play for individuals hitting their tee shots down the left side of the fairway.

#### **Scott Groh**

This is a good finishing hole. Stay left of the tree on your drive. This will give you the most level surface for your approach shot. Try to stay below the hole as there is a good back to front tilt on the green.
